Hydrogen is made using a process called electrolysis.

This uses electricity, which can be from renewable technology, such as wind turbines.

During electrolysis, electricity passes through water, splitting it into hydrogen and oxygen. The hydrogen is collected to be used as a fuel later.

When electricity is needed, the hydrogen can be used in a fuel cell. It combines with oxygen to give water and electricity.

Hydrogen can be used as a fuel in hydrogen vehicles. It can also be used to generate electricity for remote locations, such as islands.
