



Where has the Heat Gone?

1. Windows open in a room with the radiators on
Rooms with nobody in and radiators on
Cat flap
Old chimney
Old boiler
Radiators below a window
Hot tap has been left running
Thin and damaged roof insulation
Missing roof tiles
2. Radiators should be on only in rooms where it's needed
The cat flap could be covered, or made air-tight when not in use
Cover or remove the old chimney
Upgrade the boiler
Move radiators away from windows
Don't leave hot water running
Upgrade and repair roof insulation
Repair the missing roof tiles
Turn heating down and wear thicker clothes
Draught excluders can be used at the base of doors and windows
